





Donation Crowdfunding	Donation	Intangible benefits	Intrinsic and social motivation.
Reward Crowdfunding	Donation/ Pre-purchase	Rewards but also intangible benefits.	Combination of intrinsic and social motivation and desire for reward.
Crowdfunded Lending	Loan	Repayment of loan with interest. Some socially motivated lending is interest free.	Combination of intrinsic, social and financial motivation.
Equity Crowdfunding	Investment	Return on investment in time if the business does well. Rewards also offered sometimes. Intangible benefits another factor for many investors.	Combination of intrinsic, social and financial motivation.



Start a project

Start a new project on Crowdfunder, tell us the basics and a rough outline of your story. Then we can show you funds that you may be eligible for.



Apply for funding

You can then choose to make an application for a relevant fund. If a partner likes your project, they may agree to support it.

Start raising money from the crowd and once you reach an agreed percentage of your target, one of our partners could boost your total with a large donation.



The European Crowdfunding Network AISBL (ECN) and the European Investment Bank, Financial Instruments Advisory Division have co-authored a new guide for Managing Authorities: Crowdfunding and ESF opportunities: future perspectives for managing authorities (July 2020).

The manual is published by fi-compass, an advisory and guidance platform set-up by the European Commission and the European Investment Bank to support Member States in understanding and making better use of financial instruments using ESI Funds.

4.2.1 Financial instruments delivering support through crowdfunding platforms

As a preliminary consideration, and with crowdfunding being a relatively new sector of the financial services industry, there is a need to consider whether crowdfunding platforms are able to channel ESIF financial instruments.
