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Our challenges

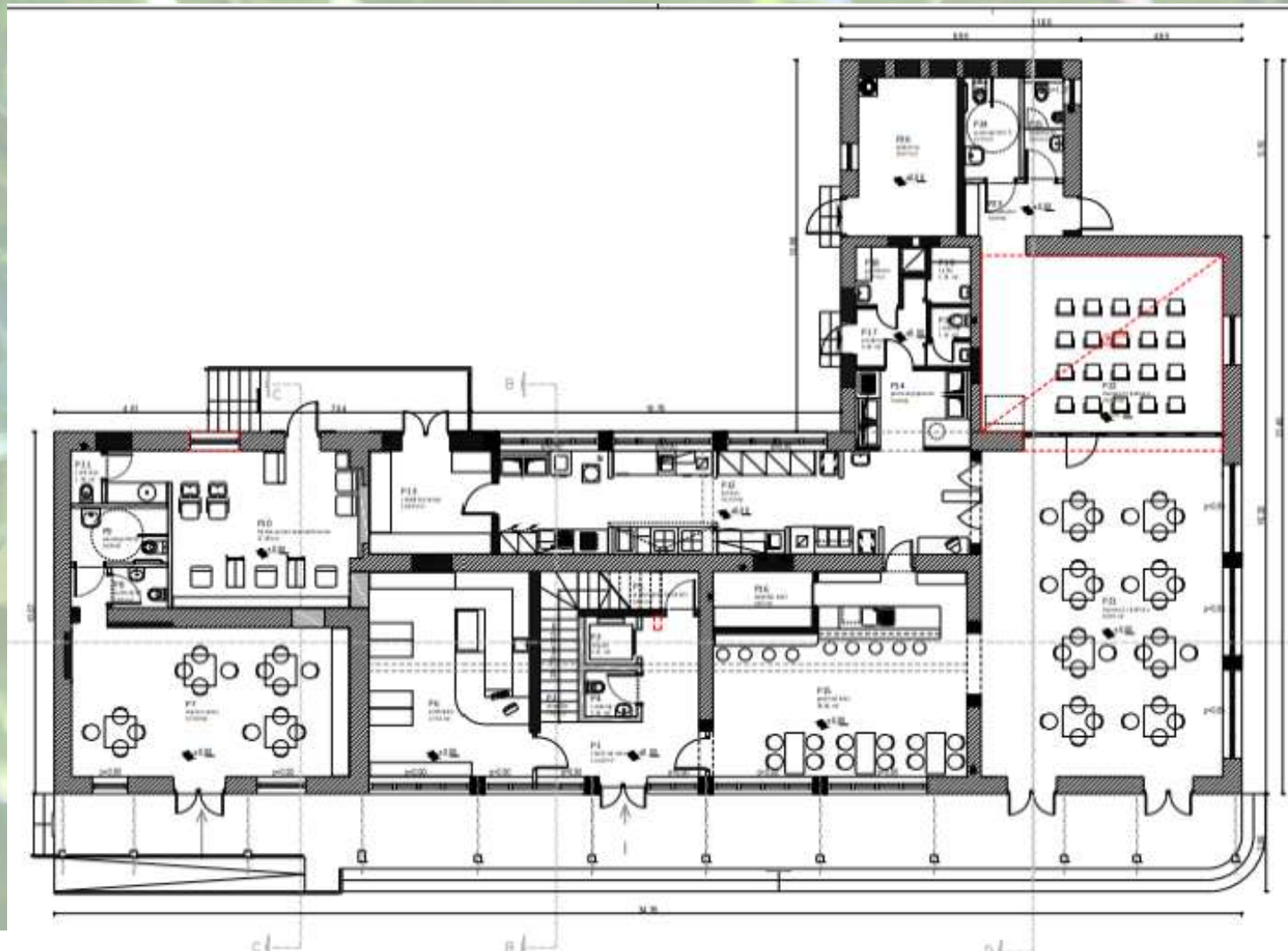
- The number of elderly people in need of care is increasing

- Limited activities and opportunities for retirees and children
- Educated young people are leaving
- Many empty old houses

Idea: Multigenerational center for everyone

- Day care for the elderly
- Center for daily activities for retirees
- Afternoon / holiday childcare
- Assisted living facility
- Restaurant
