

We see the future here. Because I want to live in a healthy environment and in coexistence with other planters.


Underused opportunities. Because the world stands on young people.

The opinion of the elderly does not affect much.


We are not informed enough, so we do not have the opportunity to influence decisions.

More could be done for youth housing. Faster response from the municipality No shops, ATMs, and social space.

Life in the villages will become more and more appreciated.

A public passenger connection with the valley is needed, communal infrastructure, the housing stock is empty or sale for weekends, which is unacceptable, too many departures of the elderly to a retirement home.

Because we are far from the centers and because there is peace.

Except for home-grown vegetables, everything has to be bought in the valley, the store is missing.


Accessibility to Tolmin (satisfactory road), missing local food offer - market.







This form of center offers benefits for the elderly as well as the young.



A space with such content would definitely positively attract people.


I think the idea is very good, especially in terms of coexistence and the transfer of knowledge between generations.



Who still today, what he does voluntarily.


All put on a commercial basis, such a center does not hold.

More than protection, workshops for children, quality leisure time with the acquisition of new knowledge and intergenerational cooperation are needed.


I believe that for many parents such help would be very welcome.

It makes sense to check the interest, the needs of the people beforehand. If the


idea comes to fruition, it will be a very big gain for Planota. We hope your efforts will not be in vain.
